

Who Are Spitzer Changemakers?

It is time for transformational, generational change with our communities in the midst of multiple emergencies. The Spitzer Changemaker Scholarship supports students who proactively and consistently work on behalf of the architecture school community, by proposing and following through on projects to change it for the better. The dean's office recognizes that students are powerful advocates for meaningful change; because students understand Spitzer from the "inside out" and the "bottom up," they offer unique, singular perspectives on the school, and come up with proposals that speak to students' needs.

Award Details

For 2022-23, undergraduate and graduate students are invited to apply for the Changemaker Scholarship; up to four will be awarded. **The scholarship offers full, in-state tuition for fall 2022 and spring 2023, and funds to support a proposed (or ongoing) service project to the architecture school.** In the past year, students, supported by this scholarship have advanced the Diversity Hour, an independent lecture series, in collaboration with NOMAS Leadership; created the Spitzer Commons website; and worked on a digital student handbook and Spitzer yearbook.

To apply for this fellowship, please complete the form below and attach your statement of purpose with your name clearly in the header explaining your project, showing how it will make Spitzer a better place to be a student, and what faculty and staff partnerships you anticipate needing. Your statement should be about 300 words. If you would like to work on a project that's already ongoing, please explain how you plan to contribute to it.

ALL Spitzer students who will return full-time in 2022-2023 are welcome to apply.

Macaulay Honors students are not eligible for the tuition award because of their tuition status; however, they may apply for project funding.
