Formal substitutions will have to be made in Degree Works on the undergraduate side when the student registers for the graduate courses in the 5th year. These substitutions will also be needed on the graduation certification for the graduate courses that will substitute for the required undergraduate courses. A transfer credit/advanced standing form will need to be filed when the student starts the master's program with the courses that will transfer from the undergraduate degree so we can add them to the graduate record.
